#### Parts of the exam

#### Theoretical part (three topics):

#### <u>Combination of theoretical and practical requirements:</u>

Electron microscopical details are also required wherever it is relevant (e.g. alveoli in the lung, enterocytes, liver sinusoids, nephron in the kidney, Sertoli cells)
