On the day of the exam:

You should have your **index**, histology lab notes, as well as a pair of forceps on you.

Repeated final exam – first retakes are free of charge, but in case of a second repeat, purchase an exam ticket at the *English secretariat* and present the yellow payment slip (or an equivalently relevant proof) before starting the exam.

Arrive by 12.50, and wait in front of the Lecture Hall.

Bring some dextrose tablets or chocolate, as well as some water, because the final exams may be long and exhausting. However, eating and drinking is prohibited at the site of the examination.

The last changes concerning deregistration from a date maybe done via the NEPTUN system 48 hours prior to the selected day.

2. Histology, practical

(2 specimens from the collection shown in the website of the Department)

Purpose: to prove the competence and knowledge on the microscopic structure of the human body using histological terms and descriptions.

Break (upon wish; 5 min maximum)

3. Theoretical part (six topics)

- a) Embryology
- b) Histology
- c) Musculoskeletal system
- d) Internal organs, organs of special senses
- e) Nervous system
- f) Maxillofacial Anatomy

Failure (mark 1) in a single question will result in failing and, consequently, repeating the whole final examination
