

COMPETITION ANNOUNCEMENT

We invite participants to the annual departmental competition held during the 12th and 13th weeks of the present semester. All three courses will write the test separately, the exact time and location will be announced later.

1st, 2nd and 3rd prizes are awarded and all participants achieving at least 70% in both rounds will be decorated with a diploma and will be entitled to certain exemptions.

**PREREQUISITE: successful semifinal examination in Anatomy1 or Anatomy3
(CV students are not eligible to participate)**

The first part of the competition is a written test held during Week 12:

ED I students - it is based on the knowledge gathered during the present semester. The content is composed of projected photographs, line drawings, or short questions concerning Macroscopy (50%), Embryology (20%) and Histology (30%)

EM II and ED II students - it includes the subject matter of all the 4 semesters. The content is composed of projected photographs, line drawings, or short questions in two separate parts: Macroscopy (45% + 5% Embryology) and Histology (45% + 5% Embryology).

The second round is open to everyone who reaches 70% in the written part. It will be held during Week 13 and will consist of a Macroscopy pin test.

EXEMPTIONS

ED I students - achieving at least 70% in the 2nd round will be exempted from the semifinal examination. Students reaching 80% or higher are offered a 5 (excellent), while those between 70-79.99% are offered a 4 (good).

ED II and EM II students - exemptions are offered only from the practical (i.e. Macroscopy and/or Histology) parts of the final examination while the theoretical (written test) part is obligatory for everybody.

Students achieving between 70 - 79,99% in the **Histology** section are exempted from the Histology part of the final examination with a 4 (good), while those reaching 80% or higher will be awarded with a 5 (excellent).

*Please note, that the **cell biology question** for old curriculum students in EM II cannot be omitted from the final examinations.*

Students reaching 70 - 79,99% in the **Macroscopy** section are exempted from the relevant part of the final examination with a 4 (good), while those reaching 80% or higher will be awarded with a 5 (excellent).
