ED I SEMIFINAL EXAMINATION ANNOUNCEMENTS Dentistry Students (regular and FM students alike)

On the day of the examination, leave your bags in a locker and gather in front of the Histology lab 10 minutes before the starting time. Please make sure you have the following items on you:

ID card/student card

SeKA login details (written down on paper – just in case)

1-2 pens

Histology notebook
in case of a retake exam – proof of payment (except for the 1st retake)

For safety reasons you may keep your valuables (money, cards, IDs, phone etc) on you, however "large" items, or pencil cases, will be collected upon entering the examination room.

Phones and smart watches are not allowed to be with you during examinations.

Regular ana2 semifinals will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the next 7 weeks.

The exams start at 12.00 in the Histology computer laboratory (Rooms 2-3)

You are going to write the test together with the 2nd year students whose test is longer (90 minutes) so we had to move the starting time to use the time better.

The test is again composed of 40 questions (only text) including approximately 30% of multiple choice questions, therefore you will have 50 minutes to complete the test.

The questions will cover Anatomy, Histology and Embryology, so there will be NO separate oral Embryology question following the written test.

Passing rate: 60%

Upon finishing the test you will silently pick up your belongings and leave the room, while the 2nd year students are still working.

Those who passed will continue the exam with the Morphology part in the old dissection room (ground floor). Please be prepared that embryologically relevant questions may be asked here too.

Students passing Morphology will return to the Histology room only when the 2nd year students are ready with the Theory part. In the meantime, please stay in the main hallway, not to disturb the fellow students writing their test between 13.00-14.00.

The examination will be finished in the Histology room, where you will be given a slide to explain. Please be prepared that embryologically relevant questions may be asked here too. Following this part, a mark will be calculated from the marks gathered during the examination as well

Students failing the examination, may repeat the exam "free" only once, every further attempt will be charged for. The total number of examination seats is set (200% of the number of students in a given course), therefore "chances" left will not automatically entitle the students to enroll in an examination if the actual number of a given day/week is full. I.e., the number of examination seats

Students not able to pass the ana2 examination during the present examination period (or in August), and still have "chances" left, may enrol in a CV course without any further requirements during the 1st semester of the next academic year (September 2018).

Please note, in this case it is not possible to continue with Anatomy 3 at the same time.
