CV COURSES FOR ED I and ED II

CV semifinal examinations (anatomy 2)

ED I

CV ana2 semifinals will be held together with regular ana1 or ana3 semifinals on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the next 7 weeks.

The exams start at 13.00 in the Histology computer laboratory (Rooms 2-3).

On the day of the examination, leave your bags in a locker and gather in front of the Histology lab 10 minutes before the starting time (12.50). Please make sure you have the following items on you:

ID card/student card
SeKA login details (written down on paper – just in case)
1-2 pens
Histology notebook
in case of a retake exam – proof of payment (except for the 1st retake)

For safety reasons you may keep your valuables (money, cards, IDs, phone etc) on you, however "large" items, or pencil cases, will be collected upon entering the examination room.

Phones and smart watches are not allowed to be with you during examinations.

The test is composed of 40 questions (only text) including approximately 30% of multiple choice questions, therefore you will have 50 minutes to complete the test. The questions will cover Anatomy, Histology and Embryology. Passing rate: 60%

Students may view their tests for a period of 5 minutes following a semifinal examination, or 10 minutes following a final examination, however, neither questions may be asked nor notes may be taken during this time. Please note that students ARE NOT ALLOWED to leave the site of examination before, or during, the viewing period.

Upon finishing the test you will be given **one Histology slide** to explain. Please be prepared that embryologically relevant questions may be asked here too.

Those who passed will continue the exam with the Morphology part in the old dissection room (ground floor). Please be prepared that embryologically relevant questions may be asked here too.

The examination will be finished in the Dissection room, where a mark will be calculated from the marks gathered during the examination as well as from the dissection room mark given by the Tutor.

Students failing the examination, may repeat the exam only if they have chances left.

The total number of examination seats is set (200% of the number of students in a given course), therefore "chances" left will not automatically entitle the students to enroll in an examination if the actual number of a given day/week is full. I.e., the number of examination seats will not be increased.

Consultations (revision): Open dissection room consultations will be available (to be announced later, please keep looking at the homepage) in the NEW DISSECTION ROOMS (top floor). There are no consultations in Histology since students may access the slide via the moodle system.

Students not able to pass the ana2 examination during the present examination period may enrol in the regular ana2 course starting in the next semester (February 2019).

CV final examinations (anatomy 4)

ED II

ANATOMY FINAL EXAMINATIONS will be held on Mondays twice during the examination period (January 7 and 28).

The exams start at 8.00 in the Histology computer laboratory (Rooms 2-3). You will be seated down in Room 3 first and then in Room 2. Second year Medicine students will join you (as previously).

On the day of the examination, leave your bags in a locker and gather in front of the Histology lab 10 minutes before the starting time. Please make sure you have the following items on you:

ID card/student card SeKA login details (written down on paper – just in case) 1-2 pens Histology notebook in case of a retake exam – proof of payment (except for the 1st retake)

For safety reasons you may keep your valuables (money, cards, IDs, phone etc) on you, however "large" items, or pencil cases, will be collected upon entering the examination room. Phones and smart watches are not allowed to be with you during examinations.

The test is composed of 100 questions (only text) including approximately 30% of multiple choice questions. The questions will cover Anatomy, Histology and Embryology. Writing time: 90 minutes.

Passing rate: 50%.

Students may view their tests for a period of 5 minutes following a semifinal examination, or 10 minutes following a final examination, however, neither questions may be asked nor notes may be taken during this time. Please note that students ARE NOT ALLOWED to leave the site of examination before, or during, the viewing period.

Upon finishing the test you will be given **2 Histology slides** and an **oral Maxillofacial question** to explain. Those who passed will continue the exam with the Morphology part in the Old Dissection room (ground floor). Please be prepared that embryologically relevant questions may be asked in both practical parts too.

The examination will be finished in the Dissection Room, where a mark will be calculated from the marks gathered during the examination as well as from the dissection room mark given by the Tutor.

Students failing the examination, may repeat the exam only if they have chances left.

Consultations (revision): Open dissection room consultations will be available (to be announced later, please keep looking at the homepage) in the NEW DISSECTION ROOMS (top floor). There are no consultations in Histology since students may access the slide via the moodle system.

The total number of examination seats is set (200% of the number of students in a given course), therefore "chances" left will not automatically entitle the students to enroll in an examination if the actual number of a given day/week is full. I.e., the number of examination seats will not be increased.

Students not able to pass the ana4 examination during the present examination period, may enroll in the regular course (Maxillofacial Anatomy – ana4) starting in February 2019.
