CV semifinals will be organized only 4 times during this examination period, and will start at 8.00 on Mondays (see in neptun). The examination follows the format of the previous exam period, however, a passing rate of **50%** will be applied here too.

Please note, that students may only have that many attempt as many they have not yet used out of the total number of 3 (or 4 when calculating with the Dean's permission's exam too).

Exams start at 8.00 in the Histology computer laboratory (Rooms 2-3).

Please make sure you have the following items on you:

SeKA login details (written down on paper – just in case)

1-2 pens

Pair of anatomical forceps

Histology notebook

in case of a retake exam - proof of payment (except for the 1st retake)

Phones and smart watches are not allowed to be with you during examinations.

You will be seated down in Room 3 first and then, if necessary, in Room 2. All three courses including 1st and 2nd year Dentistry together with 1st year Medicine join in the examination.

DENTISTRY ANATOMY 1 CV

The test is composed of 40 questions (only text).

Writing time: maximum 40 minutes.

The questions will cover Anatomy and Histology for 1st year students

Passing rate: 50%

DENTISTRY ANATOMY 3 CV

The test is composed of 40 questions (only text).

Writing time: maximum 40 minutes.

The questions will cover Anatomy, Histology and Embryology for 2nd year students

Passing rate: 50%

Upon passing the test

 1st year Medicine students will be given 2 Histology slides; - 1st year Dentistry students will be given 1 Histology slide and

1 Embryology theory question;

 2nd year Dentistry students will be given 1 Histology slide to explain.

For students passing Histology, the examination continues in the Dissection Room (Dentistry students) or in the Lenhossék Lecture Room (Medicine students).

Following a successful Morphology examination a mark will be calculated from the marks gathered during the examination as well as from the dissection room mark given by the Tutor.

Students failing the examination, may repeat the exam only if they have chances left.
