

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

As mentioned in the 6th year requirements, we emphasize that students who spend their Traumatology practice abroad must hand in a Letter of Acceptance form (For obligatory internship in Traumatology as part of the student's sixth year's curriculum) signed by the professor in charge/Head of Department at least one month prior to beginning their practice at that hospital/clinic. We cannot accept the practice of a student, if the "letter of acceptance" is handed in later than one month prior to starting the practice.

In addition, we can only allow those students to take the final exam, who fulfill the criteria of attendance of the two weeks of traumatology practice, as well as the completion of the syllabus (which can be downloaded from the Semmelweis University Traumatology Department's website) signed and stamped by the tutor. Traumatology must be attended and signed separately from the general surgery practice in the 6th year. The signature in the index requires generally 2 days.
