Any person performing with a student status in the provision of healthcare services must attend an **aptitude test**. The aptitude test is conducted by the occupational health service team of the Semmelweis University Clinical Centre. You will be informed of the test date by the English Secretariat (Tímea Kapisinszky).

Please be informed that you will only be able to pursue healthcare related professional activities if you have a valid aptitude certificate.

Please have these document with you when attending the test:

- the attached **Medical History Questionnaire**, signed and filled,
- the attached **GP's Statement**, signed and filled,
- **Statement pursuant to appendix 5. of the Work Health and Safety Policy of Semmelweis University**, signed and filled,
- **finding of a chest x-ray not older than 1 year**,
- **Statement on Health and Examination Data**
- should you have any chronic disease, a copy of its **medical documentation (outpatient form, final report)**

Please indicate your vaccination (which is not older than 6 months) on the Medical History Questionnaire and have your **vaccination record booklet** with you. If you do not have your vaccination record booklet, a Hepatis B antidote level examination will need to be done, and in terms of its result some vaccination may be necessary.

Please be informed that, you may be subjected to epidemic examinations during your studies (depending on the course and the curriculum), you will be informed of its date and location by the Dean's Office in due course.

Please also be informed that, any health related data obtained by the healthcare service shall be processed as per the terms of the CXII. Act of 2011 on self-determination and freedom of information, the XLVII. Act of 1997 on the processing and protection of medical and other related personal data, and the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (27 April 2016) on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC.

Please email me if you:

- **need to get a chest x-ray,**
- **need to go to lab to get vaccination,**
- **have all the necessary documents (it is accepted from abroad or from Hungary as well).**

I will make an appointment for you with the radiology, lab or Semmelweis University Clinical Centre.
