The goals of the course in point of view of the education: Principal aim of this course is to provide the students the complex diagnostic and therapeutic approach of the soft tissues diseases in the oral cavity, and oral manifestations of the systemic diseases of the human body.

Differential diagnostics of red and white oral lesions.</u> (Dr. Dombi Csaba)6. <u>Diseases of the salivary glands. Diagnosis and treatment. Halitosis.</u> (Dr. Czeglédy Ágota)7. <u>Differential diagnosis of the head and neck pain.</u> (Dr. Dombi Csaba)8. <u>Oral diseases affected by immune system I. (Vesiculo-bullous diseases, Oral lichen)</u> (Prof. Gera István)9. <u>Oral diseases affected by immune system II. (Aphthae and other ulcers)</u> (Prof. Gera István)10. <u>Medical problems in dentistry.</u> (Dr. Dombi Csaba)11. <u>Risk patients in dental practice.
