Summary of Comenius EVIBACE 5th meeting at Inkedaal, Vlezembeek, Belgium. 25-27. March 2015.

**Topic: Conclude.** 

All partners were represented.

1st day 24. 03. 2015.

After welcoming the new participants, guided tour was orgaised around Inkedaal. We heard some practical information about hippo and hydrotherapy integrated in Conductive Education.

In Münich the Evibace group decided to make case studies about 2-3 children. All partners used the outcome measures which were presented and chosen at the previous meetings such as GMFM, Pedi-Cat, CP-QOL, Kiddy-Kindl. The purpose of the case studies was to try the outcome measures and collect experience on how our image of the child and the information of the results matches to each other. All partners presented their oppinion on the tests.

We all agreed that, the 3 meausements give an image about the child and can be an outcome measure to evaluate the effectiveness of CE. There are some disadvantages as well. We canot cover all the items in ICF-CY CE core set. The items of cognition and communication are implied in several parts of the Pedi-Cat, but doesnot really measure them.

2nd day 25.03. 2015.

Different kind of activities were offered, such as observation in kindergarden, preschool CE session or presentation about gait analysis.

We decided some contents of the handbook and the final report.

An interesting presentation about neuropsychological aspects in Conductive Education was given by Szilvia Szeleczky (conductor) and Dr Koen Matthys (rehabilitation specialist).

## 3rd day 26.03. 2015.

The tasks for the final report and the handbook are dealed between the partners.

We agreed in the topics for the last meeting to complete our partnership.

Every institution will work on the implementation of outcome measures in their own practice.

Further on, our tasks will be to invite CE institutions to use the measurements and find a way to exchange experience and information.

The last meeting will be at Joriel School in Stockholm from 20-22. May.
