Our curriculum will be continued from next week and e-learning is the preferred method to maintain and progress your education. First, we will submit missed histopathology practice for EM6 and 8 to the e-learning website of the University, and we will provide online opportunity to complete midterm I of the recent semester. In addition, you will be able to reach videos (narrated ppt presentations) of the lectures and histopathology practices in the upcoming weeks until the regular way of teaching will be reestablished. All the materials will be available in the e-learning system of the Semmelweis University by your SeKa account. Moreover, we are planning to share audiovisual records about interesting autopsy cases, 1-2 cases per week.

Once or twice in every week in the time of one of the regular practices we are planning to provide an interactive online consultation opportunity in the ZOOM system. Obviously, in case of a more extended interest, we will provide additional consultations. Online consultation will be performed through Zoom, and previously you will be informed about the available links of registration.

Please let us know if you have any technical problem by joining e-learning system, and we will try to provide you a support. Please follow the information sent by NEPTUN or by our institutional web site. In this interim period e-learning education will follow the previously established schedule of the practices and lectures of our Department. Please let us know if our suggested consultation time overlaps with other subjects' online class.

In order to maintain the most effective way of your education, we are asking you to learn our online materials for being capable to ask valuable questions during the consultations. Despite the extraordinary situation, professional expectation for the final exam is not going to change. Therefore we will do all of our best to prepare you for the exam in all the way of regular and e-learning methods.
