## EDUCATIONAL INFORMATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACOLOGY AND PHARMACOTHERAPY FOR THE 4<sup>th</sup> YEAR STUDENTS (FACULTY OF DENTISTRY)

(2018/2019 study year)

- 1.) **Textbook:** Katzung: Basic and Clinical Pharmacology 12<sup>th</sup> Edition
- 2.) **Requirements**: Textbook + the material of the lectures and seminars.
- 3.) **Number of absences** from the seminars and lectures is **max 4** during one semester. In case of more than 4 absences, signature will be refused. Checking the presence is regular during the seminars and occasional in the lectures.
- 4.) **Midterm tests:** two midterm tests will be organized during the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester The participation is not obligatory.

## 5.) Order of exam

There is no exam possibility before and after the official examination period unless the student has permission from the Dean or the Rector.

1st semester: semi-final exam (oral from the topics of the 1st semester), applying for the exam via the NEPTUN.

Offering a grade based on the performance in the regular period of the semester:

There will be two midterm-tests in the second part of the regular period (see schedule of practices on the home page) and if the results of these midterms will be better than 80 %, there is a possibility to do a 3<sup>rd</sup> oral demonstration during the last week of the regular period (the topic of this demonstration is the topic of the semi-final exam). If the result of this oral demonstration is good or excellent the lecturer may offer a grade of 4 or 5. The student is not obliged to accept the grade offered and may request to take the exam.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> semester:

Registration to the announced exam dates should be arranged through the NEPTUN system.

In order to register for the **final exam** a successful **prescription writing** exam is required. The prescription writing exam is during the last pharmacology practice, the examiner is the seminar-teacher of the student. The prescription writing must be done before the day of the final exam latest. Students who repeat the year and the subject must take prescription writing again. The results will be reported by the teacher to the tutor who will provide them to the examiners.

The information about the examiners will be mounted on the door of the 4<sup>th</sup> floor on each day of the final exam.

The form of the exam is **oral** after taking three topics and providing a sufficient time to prepare. The topics are from the three lists of the final exam questions (A, B, C, see the list on the website) respectively. The examiner's decision will be based on the answers to the three topics. The mark will be registered in the NEPTUN system.

**Retaking** a failed exam or improving the grade is possible only 3 days after the previous

**Missing an exam**: The absence must be justified within three working days otherwise a "not shown up" mark will be registered in the NEPTUN.

## 6). Competition

A competition will be organised in the  $2^{nd}$  semester of the study year 2017/2018, on the last day of the study period. In order to register to the competition both midterm tests of the  $2^{nd}$  semester should reach 80%.

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
