- a scientific study with new interdisciplinary references of the own research field in a peer-reviewed journal
- book or bookchapter in a scientific book implying the own research field (ISBN registration)

in SCI in SSCI-ben, or journals listed in. <i>Appendix 24</i>	First author : 5 points, Coauthor 4 points.
in a peer -reviewed international journal, book	First author: 3 points, Coauthor: 2 points.
in a peer -reviewed national journal, book	First author 2 points, Coauthor: 1 pont.
Book	First author: 6 points, Coauthor :4 points.
