## Detailed information on the 6th Summer University

Dear Citizens of Semmelweis University,

In the following we would like to share some practical information concerning the 6<sup>th</sup> Summer University.

Previously, the duration of the event has been 2 days, but this year it has been extended by an extra day, in which we are working in collaboration with our Green University Project team. We intend to **put more emphasis on sustainability and environmental awareness**, as well as on developing a **healthy lifestyle** and a balance between **physical and mental well-being**. Therefore, on this day students will have the opportunity to attend lectures on the subjects described above.

There has also been a slight change of venue, with the **Hungarian program** still taking place at the **Basic Medical Science Center (EOK)** and the **international program** at the **NET-building in Nagyvárad Square**.

The course is available in the Neptun system as a separate optional course, for which registration starts on 21 August 2024 at 10:00 am. The deadline for registration is 27 August at 23:59. Students can earn 1 credit per day for their participation, so those who attend all three days can earn 3 credit points. In the Neptun system, under "Subjects" please select "Register for subject", set term to "2024/25/1", select "All other subjects in the institution" as subject type, then enter the respective subject code.

## Subject codes in the Neptun system are:

**SENYEGY6\_01\_AN** – Day 0 International Green University Day

**SENYEGY6\_02\_AN** – Day 1 international program

**SENYEGY6\_03\_AN** – Day 2 international program

To earn the respective credit points, students must register for the course and attend the event in person. Attendance will be verified by barcode scanning also this year. The Hungarian course is only open to active students enrolled in Semmelweis University's Hungarian courses, while the international course is only available to students enrolled in the German and English language programs of the University.

On all three days of the 6th Summer University, the international program (exclusively in English) will start at 9 a.m., according to the schedule published on the <u>website of the Alumni Directorate</u> and also shared as a <u>Facebook event</u>.

On all three days of the international program, admission will start already at 8 am.

As in previous years, students will be welcomed with cold water, fresh fruit and coffee, free of charge throughout the day.

## **Entry:**

We will still use a barcode system for registering entry and exit at the main entrance of the NET Building, but in a slightly different way. A unique barcode,

which can be obtained through a dedicated registration interface, will be sent to registered participants by e-mail. Upon registration, any valid e-mail address can be used. The barcode received must be presented to our registration staff, who will scan it, by which it will be recorded in the system and a green light will indicate that the registration has been successful. The barcode is unique and is assigned to the Neptun code of the student that registered, it is not transferable (and not worth transferring either). Should it be passed on to somebody else, it will still register the entry and/or exit of the person who passed on the barcode, thus preventing the intended new user from earning the credit point(s).

## The conditions for obtaining the credit point(s) are:

- On day 0 (28.08.) of the international program, check-in should be completed no later than 08:55. Checkout is possible from 16:45 at the earliest.
- On day 1 (29.08.) of the international program check-in should be completed no later than 08:55. Checkout is possible from 16:25 at the earliest.
- On day 2 (30.08.) of the international program check-in should be completed no later than 08:55. Checkout is possible from 15:05 at the earliest.
- Random attendance checks by QR code scanner are possible anytime during the three days of the event.

If a student does not fulfil the above conditions, the course will not be accepted as completed. Complaints will only be accepted if the student can present the barcode that appears in green upon registration of entry.

Students who have signed up for the course but for whatever reason are unable to attend the event, are kindly requested to withdraw their registration in Neptun as soon as possible prior to the event, to enable those who were unable to register but would like to attend to do so. The deadline for dropping the course is 23:59 on 27.08.

Complaints regarding dropping the course will not be accepted after the specified deadline. If the student does not attend the event and fails to drop the course in time, the course will not be signed off in Neptun as completed and will be calculated in the semester average as a fail, with no possibility of recourse.

We would like to emphasize that on the day of the event, if students fail to register in the attendance control system by the given deadline, the subject will be marked in Neptun as not completed.
