## Parts of the exam

### **Dissection part**

- 3. Digestive and/or respiratory systems (anatomy and embryology)
- 4. Urogenital system (anatomy and embryology)

5. One histological slide chosen from the slide collection studied during the semester. Purpose: To prove the competence and knowledge on the microscopic structure of the inner organs, using histological terms and descriptions.
