Parts of the exam

Dissection part

1. Students not passing either of the macroscopy midterms should start the examination in the dissection room.
The topics include the subject matter of the entire semester.

Theoretical part (three topics):

2. Heart, circulatory and lymphatic systems (anatomy and embryology)
3. Digestive and/or respiratory systems (anatomy and embryology)
4. Urogenital system (anatomy and embryology)

Histology part

5. One histological slide chosen from the slide collection studied during the semester.
Purpose: To prove the competence and knowledge on the microscopic structure of the inner organs, using histological terms and descriptions.
