

Anatomy, Histology and Embryology Competition
for 1st year
English Medical Students

The two rounds of the competition will be held presumably on the 12. and 13. weeks. The exact dates and times will be published soon.

Prerequisite: successful Anatomy, Histology and Embryology I. exam.

Topics of the first round: the complete material of the second semester (approx. 50% anatomy, 30% histology and 20% embryology), with projected pictures and their related theoretical questions.

Topics of the second round: gross anatomy pin test

Only those students can attend the second round who achieve 70% on the first. To provide anonymity the tests are written with nicknames and names will be revealed when the students reach good results.

The students who achieve 70% on the second round can get exemption from the semifinal exam with an offered grade (70-79,99%: 4, equal or higher than 80%: 5).

For those students who take part in both rounds, the average of the two results will give a final order and the best three students will receive a prize beside the exemption.
