

DEPARTMENTAL COMPETITION IN ANATOMY, HISTOLOGY AND EMBRYOLOGY

ED 2nd year

April 1, 2019

The Department of Anatomy, Histology and Embryology invites **all students with a successful anatomy 3 examination** to participate in the annual competition.

The competition is composed of two consecutive sessions.

Only those students may continue in the 2nd round who have achieved at least 70% from the 1st round.

1ST ROUND: written, e-learning type test

THEORY QUESTIONS - simple and multiple choice questions

IDENTIFICATION OF SELECTED STRUCTURES - on morphological, histological and embryological images.

Topics of the 1st round: the complete subject matter of the 4 semesters (approximately 60 % Anatomy, 20 % Histology, 20 % Embryology)

Date: April 30 (Tuesday - Faculty day) between 8.00 and 9.30 (the exact time is **to be announced**)

Place: Digital Histology Laboratories

2ND ROUND

PIN TEST - identification of labelled structures on prosected specimen

Topics of the 2nd round: the complete subject matter of the 4 semesters

Date: during week 13. (May 6-10), the exact day/time is **to be announced**

Place: Anatomy Museum

The final result of the competition will be calculated from the summary of the two consecutive rounds.

Examination exemptions

Students achieving at least **80%** from the 1st round will be offered an examination mark **excellent (5)** while students achieving between **70 - 79.99%** will be offered a mark **good (4)** and will be exempted from the **written test** of the final examination.

Students achieving at least **80%** from the 2nd round will be offered an examination mark **excellent (5)**, while students achieving between **70 - 79.99%** will be offered a mark **good (4)** and will be exempted from the **Morphology part** of the final examination.

The winners of the competition will be decorated with a diploma besides the examination exemptions.
