INFORMATION ABOUT THE FINAL EXAM for the 2nd YEAR EM STUDENTS

The exams will be held on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the exam period.

N.B. The last changes concerning **registration/deregistration** from a date maybe done via the NEPTUN system **48 hours before** to the chosen day. The department reserves the right not to deregister students missing the deregistration deadline.

Parts of the final exam:

- 1) Written test at the 1st histology lab: Anatomy, Histology and Embryology: 100 questions/90min (50% of answers will have to be passed for the successful test)
- 2) Histology: 3 slides (oral exam)
- 3) Gross Anatomy exam at the 1st floor dissection room (oral exam)

Even failing (1) a part of the exam will result in an unsuccessful final exam. Retakes may be attempted earliest in 3 working days.

In case of an unsuccessful exam, the first retake will be free of charge, while for a **second retake exam** you will need to pay a fee ahead of the exam and present a proof of it upon entering the exam room.

The exams start at 12 p.m.

On the day of the exam, leave your belonging in a locker (1st floor dissection room) and gather in front of the Histology labs at least 10 minutes before the exam starts.

Please, remember to have your

- ID or Student Card
- Pens (only for the Histology part)
- Admin name and password for SeKA login

Furthermore

Mobile phones, smart watches and any electronic devices are prohibited.

Written test

Topics:

- 1. Anatomy and embryology of the locomotor system.
- 2. Anatomy, histology and embryology of the internal organs.
- 3. Anatomy, histology and embryology of the nervous system, sensory organs and endocrine organs; skin and appendages.
- 4. Regional anatomy of the human body.

Students will be seated at the computers (no pens or other tools are allowed for this part) and the exam starts when everybody is logged in. Students are responsible for having a correct login name and password on them or they will be suspended and the exam is invalid (fail).

Students using illegal devices will be suspended and an official investigation together with a university disciplinary procedure will follow.

Upon finishing the test, students will immediately be able to see their results and they can have a look at their correct and/or wrong answers as well. There will be no separate possibility to view the tests.

Histology - oral exam

Topics:

- 1. Slides of the first semester
- 2. Slides of the second semester
- 3. Slides of the third semester

Students will be seated for Histology and will get three slides (three numbers) to view.

Students ready with the Histology part should wait in the hallway, and then they will be escorted to the next exam part.

Gross Anatomy - oral exam

Topics:

- 1. Gross anatomy of the locomotor system (including trunk, head and neck muscles, muscular triangles, fasciae, bones and joints).
- 2. Gross anatomy of the internal organs (including respiratory, cardiovascular, gastrointestinal, urogenital and lymphatic systems; diaphragm and pelvic cavity).
- 3. Gross anatomy of the complete nervous system; endocrine and sensory organs.
- 4. Regional anatomy of the human body.
- 5. Cross sections of the neck, chest cavity, abdominal cavity and pelvis.

In case of, unsuccessful anatomy final exam the exam may be postponed to the following exam period (as a 'CV' exam), if you have exam chance(s) left. For further details, please consult the Calendar 2018/2019.
