

Exam announcement - Developmental Biology

The exams period of the 2019/20 2nd semester in Semmelweis University is between 18th of May and 3th of July 2020. The exams will be organized according to the distance teaching.

The grade from Developmental Biology can be achieved as follows.

Developmental Biology I. CV exam for those ones who participated the course during 2019/2020 1st semester

The exams are online Moodle tests, the students can take it remotely, from home. Students are entitled to log in the Moodle system and have an attempt at the test ONLY if they are registered in the Neptun system. The department may limit the accessibility of the tests by using a specific password for each occasion. Once a student has logged in to see/try the test it will automatically be considered as an attempt to pass the test, thus the number of available exam chances will be reduced.

Developmental Biology II. 2019/2020 2nd semester (normal and FM courses) Developmental Biology I. CV course for those ones who received the signature in former years (in 2016, 2017, 2018)

A topic list related to the lecture titles will be announced. (for CV course students, the 2018/2019 1st semester topic list will be used).

Every student will have to write short summaries about two of these - for the summaries the lecture material and textbooks, online literature can be used.

Format requirements: minimum 2000, maximum 5000 character (with spaces) (per topic) in a word (docx) or pdf file.

Avoid copy-paste since plagiarism checker will be applied.

The title of the 2 topics and the email address to which the papers should be sent you will receive in a Neptun-message.

Deadlines (there are 3 possibilities):

A) In case of papers sent by 15th of May 2020, the student should register to the exam announced on 18th of May 2020. The grade will be announced also on the Neptun.

B) The next possible deadline is 12th June 2020, in this case the student should register to the Neptun exam of 15th of June 2020.

C) In case the papers are not sent by 12th June 2020, the student may participate on a regular exam (with personal attendance) organized later - in this case the announced topics will be the topics of the written exam.
