

## Practical Exam Announcement

Dear Students,

To complete the Macroscopic Anatomy II., everyone should take a practical oral exam. (NOTE: only those students are eligible to take the practical exam who passed the Macroscopic Anatomy I. exam)

The final grade of the Macroscopic Anatomy II. consists of the electronic (Moodle) test (25%) and the practical oral exam (locomotor system+internal organs+neuroanatomy=75%). If you fail the practical exam, you do not need to retake the electronic test during this exam period just the practical one.

**In the week prior** to the practical exam, students must attend a mandatory practical review (**4x 165 minutes**) to revise the specimens. (Attendance is in your best interest.)

Since we have already finished the material by Zoom meetings, you can revise the specimens individually but you have opportunity to ask from a teacher in each time. However, we do not give regular practices.

The practical exams are held in turns at the following dates.

To register for a ***review period*** (reserving a place in a dissection room), we are going to send a different link prior the review period only for those who registered for the practical exam before.

**Pre-triage regulations:**

Those students who returned to Hungary from abroad ***during the exam period*** must present 1 negative PCR test evaluated by the Semmelweis University when first entering the Anatomy Department.

Students who have been continuously in Hungary since the beginning of the exam period (18 May) only need to declare this upon first entry, a negative PCR test is not required.
