EXAMINATIONS

All final and semifinal exams are held in person on the departmental premises. No online/zoom examinations will be available during the August examination period. All successful partial exam marks earned during May-June-July are valid for the present period (only). The same pandemic safety protocol applies to the examinations as earlier.

EM II and ED II Anatomy, Histology and Embryology IV.

Students will have to sit for ONLY those parts of the final examination which have not yet been successfully done. Written tests start at 8.00 on the designated days (**please arrive by 7.40.**) Histology (and Maxillofacial Anatomy for the Faculty of Dentistry) parts start approximately at 9.00.

CV examinations are organized as „written only” tests held in the Histology Laboratories of the department starting at 8.00 on the designated days. **Please arrive by 7.40.**

ED I Macroscopic Anatomy II.

The written part starts in the Histology laboratory at 8.00 on the designated day. **Please arrive by 7.40.** Oral exams in Macroscopic Anatomy II will be held in the lecture hall, starting approximately at 9.00. Those who only need to sit for this part, should arrive between **8.40-8.45** on the day of the examination.

ED I Microscopic Anatomy I.

The semifinal exams are organized as „written only” tests held in the Histology Laboratories of the department starting at 8.00 on the designated days. **Please arrive by 7.40.**

In case of an unsuccessful final or semifinal examination, students may use their remaining possibilities to reattempt the examination as a CV exam in the following, winter, exam period.
