- bones (vertebrae and ribs), ligaments, joints, muscles and movements of the trunk;
- skull: bones and spaces, connections;
- components and actions of the temporomandibular joint; muscles of mastication;
- muscles of facial expression;
- neck muscles, muscle trigones; superficial and deep nuchal muscles
- cervical fasciae

The test is composed of 20 (simple or multiple choice) questions, with some of them containing pictures. The writing time is 20 minutes. Passing rate (2) - 60%, (3) -70%, (4) -80%, (5) -90%. Once the tests are submitted, the program will automatically calculate the mark/result.
