TOPIC LIST

Macroscopy of the head and neck region (bones, muscles, vessels, nerves, internal organs, spaces)
WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO

- cranial nerve nuclei, fibres, types of fibres, innervation of salivary glands, brainstem, cranial nerve exits (brain, dura, skull), innervation of the dura mater
- neck muscles, muscle triangles
- muscles of facial expression
- cervical parts of the airways and the esophagus
- orbit
- skull, connections of the skull spaces

Embryology questions will not form part of the midterm test.

The muscles of the nape will not be included in the topic list

Practical specimens: cadaver, trunk, half head, head, cervical viscera, skull
