Information about Midterms of Anatomy subject (English Pharmacy)

There are **two Midterms** from Anatomy.

These Midterms are **not compulsory**.

"Midterms:Midterms are "non-compulsory assessment", from the topics "locomotor system, internal organs" and "nervous system, sensory organs, endocrine organs, general embryology", respectively. Its form is identical with the one of the semifinal exam (electronic, Moodle test). Successful (at least 50%) midterm provides the student with the exemption of the corresponding part of the examination, and if accepted, it is counted into the result of the semifinal exam."

On the base of the result of the **two successful (at least grade 2, more than 50% of the points) Midterms** a semifinal **exam grade** is formed, **acceptance of it is not obligatory**.

Time, place and topics of Midterms:

- **1st Midterm:** 10th week, **24/04/2026, Friday, 15.15, CityCorner Building**
(topics: **locomotor system, basic tissues, internal organs**) (maximum: 60 points)
- **2nd Midterm:** 14th week, **22/05/2026, Friday, 15.15, CityCorner Building**
(topics: **central and peripheral nervous system, sensory organs, endocrine system, general embryology**) (maximum: 20 points)

Mode of Midterms

- Midterms are Moodle tests (SeKA password is needed). Midterms are held in the Histology Rooms.

Forming of semifinal grade

If **both Midterms are successful (at least grade 2, more than 50% of the points)**, according to the **sum of the points of the two Midterms**, a semifinal grade is formed:

SUM of the points of the two Midterms	grade
40.0-49.9	2
50.0-59.9	3
60.0-69.9	4
70.0-80.0	5

Those students, **who do not accept the grade**, can take an exam in the exam's period.

Those students, **who accept the grade** calculated on the base of the two Midterms, **are asked to register on the Neptun**
to the exam of 26/05/2026.
