decision No 7/2020 (15 September 2020) of the 2020/2021 academic year

on introducing a compulsory subject called “Comprehensive theory of coronavirus and the practice of correct upper respiratory tract sampling” at the Faculty of Medicine

1. Faculty of Medicine Council, under the mandate based on the Faculty Council’s Organizational and Operational Regulations Book I, part1.1, chapter III, Paragraph 115/ (2)/f), has discussed the introduction of a compulsory subject called **“Comprehensive theory of coronavirus and the practice of correct upper respiratory tract sampling”**, and **via an electronic voting system with the voting results by open ballot – by majority, 48 ‘yes’, 4 ‘no’ and 4 abstention – accepted it with the value of 1 credit at the Faculty of Medicine.** The subject will be introduced in the first term of the 7-8th, 9-10th and the 11-12th semesters of the 2020/2021 academic year with the system of requirements shown in the appendix, provided that, along with the subjects not affected by the amendment, it will form a unified structure with the subject requirements systems approved for the academic year 2019/2020 by the Senate decision 156/2020 (VII. 30.).
2. The implementation deadline for the current decision: next senate session.
3. Requested to take action: Dean of the Faculty of Medicine
4. This decision enters into force on **16 September 2020.**
