<b>Objectives of the subject, its place in the medical curriculum:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In Module III of the course "Student Policlinic", the students shall deepen practical skills interdisciplinary in a diverse patient clientele. The students apply their acquired theoretical knowledge in particular from the modules "Policlinics I and II" in practice and extend their abilities especially with regard to the differential diagnosis and the treatment or therapy of common medical disorders.</li><li>• This elective course is offered in addition to the regular internships of the curriculum, as the students will be treating many illnesses and injuries due to the general medical focus or the special patient clientele in "Student Policlinic", with whom they will otherwise not be confronted in the day-to-day operation of the hospitals. Given this emphasis, this subject supportively fits into the compulsory curriculum as a connecting and complementary theoretical as well as a practical element and is at the same time an answer to the growing importance of general medicine in medical education in Germany.</li></ul>

<b>Successful completion of the subject results in the acquisition of the following competencies:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Examination skills and diagnosis in general medicine</li><li>• New knowledge of medical cases</li></ul>

- Theoretical knowledge and practical skills of wound treatment and substance abuse
- Advanced knowledge regarding ambulatory treatment as well as regarding the challenges and processes of a general practitioner's office
- Increased awareness of the woes and needs of poor (in particular homeless and non-insured) people and of the ethos and the duty of doctors to treat all patients, regardless of their social status



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**Requirements for participation in classes and the possibility to make up for absences:**
