Objectives of the subject, its place in the medical curriculum:

- In Module III of the course "Student Policlinic", the students shall deepen practical skills
 interdisciplinary in a diverse patient clientele. The students apply their acquired theoretical
 knowledge in particular from the modules "Policlinics I and II" in practice and extend their
 abilities especially with regard to the differential diagnosis and the treatment or therapy of
 common medical disorders.
- This elective course is offered in addition to the regular internships of the curriculum, as the students will be treating many illnesses and injuries due to the general medical focus or the special patient clientele in "Student Policlinic", with whom they will otherwise not be confronted in the day-to-day operation of the hospitals. Given this emphasis, this subject supportively fits into the compulsory curriculum as a connecting and complementary theoretical as well as a practical element and is at the same time an answer to the growing importance of general medicine in medical education in Germany.
