Decision No 37/2024 (10 June 2024)
of the 2023/2024 academic year

on the occupied place of the Department of Neurosurgery, the Department of Rehabilitation Medicine, the Department of Traumatology, the departmental groups attached to them and the Department of Clinical Psychology within the University

1. § The Faculty Council of the Faculty of Medicine based on the provisions of the Organisational and Operational Regulations I.1., 120. § (2) f) and (3) a) discussed and supported the proposal on the status of the Department of Neurosurgery, the Department of Rehabilitation Medicine, the Department of Traumatology, the Department of Traumatology, the departmental groups assigned to them and the Department of Clinical Psychology within the University.

The Faculty Council via an open electronic voting system, unanimously with 64 votes in favour, 0 against and 0 abstentions supported the Faculty's initiative to the Senate to adopt the following decision.

The Department of Neurosurgery shall continue to operate as part of the Clinic for Neurosurgery and Neurointervention. The Neurointervention Departmental Group would continue to operate as the Neurointervention Department within the Clinic for Neurosurgery and Neurointervention and the Department of Functional Neurosurgery shall be ceased.

The Department of Rehabilitation Medicine shall be attached to the Clinic for Rehabilitation and will be known as the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.

The Department of Traumatology would be merged into the Traumatology Clinic and as a result would cease to exist as a separate teaching and research unit. The Clinic for Traumatology would perform its patient care activities within the Clinical Centre and its teaching and research activities within the Faculty of Medicine.

The Departmental Group of Sports Surgery and Sports Medicine Group, which was attached to the Department of Traumatology, shall be ceased, as shall the Neurotraumatology Department Group II. Division I would continue to function under the direct authority of the Dean as the Neurotraumatology Departmental Group.

Finally, it is proposed that the Department of Clinical Psychology should continue to function as part of the Clinic for Psychiatry and Psychotherapy, given that the Department of Clinical Psychology is also involved in patient care and is closely linked to psychiatry.

3. § Responsible: Dean of the Faculty of Medicine.
4. § This decision enters into force upon publication on the website of the Faculty.
