

General conditions of exemptions from examinations

1. Exemption for Medical Biochemistry 1-2-3 may be given only if students pass an exemption examination
2. **Prerequisite of participating in the exemption exam:** previous studies and successful examinations in the subject *Biochemistry*
3. **Documents to be attached on the previous studies:**
 - a *transcript* from the former University, containing the name of courses taken in Biochemistry, examination grades and a copy of your final BSc or MSc diploma (if you have)
 - a *topic list of Biochemistry (bioenergetics, metabolism of carbohydrates, lipids, amino acids, nucleotides, biochemistry of tissues, neurobiochemistry, signal transduction, hemostasis)*
 - the indication of the used textbook(s) is also recommended
4. *Grade 2 or better in subject matter Medical Chemistry*
5. *An oral checking examinations in Biochemistry*
 - will be organized by our examination committee.
6. The exemption examinations take place on the 5th or 6th week of the semester; the deadline to present your documents is 22th of February, 2019.
7. In case of unsuccessful exemption examination there are not any negative consequences. You have to attend practical throughout the semester and sit for the regular examination at the end of the semester like the rest of students.
