How to apply: Applications must be submitted by sending the conference details (including costs), the abstract of the oral or poster presentation, or a maximum one-page motivation letter in case of participation without presentation to **kotnyek.orsolya@semmelweis.hu**.

Deadline for application: 24.03.2023.

Deadline for decision: 31.03.2023.

The language of the application is English.

Applicants will be notified of the outcome by email.

Successful applicants have to acknowledge funding from the BIOSAFETY project in their oral or poster presentations.
