# on the operation of electronic surveillance systems installed on the territory of Semmelweis **University (SE)**

Type of recording: Purpose of recording: digital

to prevent and deter illegal acts for the protection of human life, physical integrity, personal freedom, the safeguarding of hazardous substances, the protection of business, banking and

securities, and property protection

to prevent, detect and interrupt terrorist acts or other crimes, to perform national security protection and prevention, information gathering, as well as national security, industrial security, internal security and crime prevention control tasks, to perform disaster protection and fire protection authority tasks, in order to identify

a wanted person or object

#### Data controllers:

- 1. The Security Directorate (BTI) is entitled to view recorded recordings:
  - director (BTI),
  - the head of the property protection department,
  - or the person designated by them, and BTI workers
- 2. The following persons are entitled to view live images:
  - director (BTI),
  - the head of the property protection department,
  - or a person designated by them and BTI workers

The data controllers are subject to an occupational (professional) confidentiality obligation with regard to all data/information that comes to their attention, pursuant to Section 22 (1) of Act CXXXIII of 2005.

## Tasks with recorded recordings:

Pursuant to Section 31 of Act CXXXIII of 2005 on the rules of personal and property protection and private investigator activities:

- When viewing recorded recordings, a report must be prepared pursuant to Section 31 of Act CXXXIII of 2005., the report block shall be issued by the Security Directorate.
- The digital recording device automatically ensures that recordings that have not been used for more than thirty days are destroyed.
- The use can never be for personal purposes, and their release is only possible upon request from a court or authority.
