

## CALL FOR TEACHING ASSISTANT (TA) PROPOSALS

The Department of Medical Chemistry, Molecular Biology and Pathobiochemistry of the Semmelweis University offers teaching assistant (TA) positions for international students of the Medical Faculty of the Semmelweis University for the 2020/21 academical year with the following terms:

1. Successful applicants are supposed to assist at lab (practical) lessons held at the Dept. of Medical Chemistry, Molecular Biology and Pathobiochemistry and at its legal successor, Department of Molecular Biology of the Institute of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology in the following courses: Medical Chemistry and Molecular Cell Biology 1 (1st semester); Molecular Cell Biology 2 (2nd semester).
2. Proposals have to be submitted to the Secretariat of the Dept. of Medical Chemistry, Molecular Biology and Pathobiochemistry (H-1094 Budapest, Tüzoltó u. 37-47) before 15th July, 2020. Submitted proposals will be evaluated by the Dean of the Medical Faculty in cooperation with the Student Government Organization by the beginning of the fall semester, and applicants will be informed on the decision in due course.
3. Teaching assistants' tasks and obligations include active participation and assistance in the practical education of students during lab lessons (presentation of the theoretical background of the corresponding experiment; technical assistance and supervision of students; critical evaluation and discussion of results; holding consultations). Teaching assistants have to submit a detailed summary on their teaching activities to the head of the Dept. of Molecular Biology by the end of the spring semester. This is prerequisite for the official acknowledgement of the teaching assistant's activity as an elective course.
4. The duration of the TA position covers both semesters of the 2020/21. academical year. The minimal working time corresponds to the duration of lab lessons of the selected course but cannot exceed 50 hours a month.
5. Successful applicants will receive a scholarship the amount of which is currently under negotiation.
6. An essential prerequisite for getting the TA position is that the arithmetical average of the marks received in the previous two semesters is at least 4.00, and the applicant passed his Medical Chemistry and both Molecular Cell Biology exams with the best mark.
