

Information about the “Competition exam” to obtain semi-final exam grade  
Faculty of Medicine  
Faculty of Dentistry  
(2019/2020)

The student whose average of weekly tests taken into account is at least 80% can have the possibility to get exemption from the semi-final exam. The “Competition exam” test will be held on 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 (Thursday), 17:00-18:30. Venue: Szent-Györgyi Lecture Hall. To be eligible for the participation, the students must register at their practice teacher in advance. This registration is not the registration for the semi-final exam. (Since competition exam may not yield an offered grade, please, register for the semi-final exam through the NEPTUN system as usual!).

The test covers the material of the first semester, and composed by 30 multiple choice and 4 essay questions. The results will be announced through a NEPTUN message during the evening of 12<sup>th</sup> December, 2019.

The students need to bring ID card to the test. The following rules will be enforced during the checking test: electronic devices must be kept in the baggage; baggage and overcoats should be placed next to the wall of the lecture halls; any form of communication is disallowed; students not complying with these rules will be disqualified immediately.

Based on the result of the test the following semi-final grades will be offered to the participants: 75-84% = 4, 85-100% = 5.

The students, who accept the offered grade, should re-register from their semi-final exam slot to 16<sup>th</sup> December, 2019 and the grades will be entered into the NEPTUN system.

If you do not accept the offered grade you can keep your original registration for your semi-final exam.
