

Information about the “Competition”

(2019/2020)

The student whose average of weekly tests taken into account (number of the tests in this semester minus three) is at least 80% can have the possibility to participate in the competition. The test will be held on 14th May, 2020 (Thursday), 17:00-18:30 (Venue: Szent-Györgyi Lecture Hall). To be eligible for the participation, the students must register at their practice teacher in advance (the deadline for application is 13th May, 2020).

The competition covers the material of both semesters and it is composed of 30 multiple choice and 4 essay questions. The results will be announced on 15th May, 2020 (Friday).

The students need to bring an ID card to the test. The following rules will be enforced during the competition: electronic devices must be kept in the baggage; baggage and overcoats should be placed next to the wall of the lecture halls; any form of communication is disallowed; students not complying with these rules will be disqualified immediately.

Based on the result of the test the following partial (written exam) grade is offered to the participants: 80-100% = 5.

For these students, the oral exam starts at 9:45 on the day of their final exam.

Only the winners of the competition (three students from the Faculty of Medicine and one from the Faculty of Dentistry) may have a chance to get an exemption from the final exam depending on the results. These students will be notified through a NEPTUN message to meet with the Course Director (Dr. Péter Várnai) and the awarding of the exemption will be based on a discussion with Dr. Várnai on 15th May, 2020 (Friday).
