## Action plan based on the student feedback received in the second semester of the 2023/24 academic year (AOKELT792\_2A)

## Our feedback on general comments by the students:

We have received the results of the online questionnaires submitted by students regarding our teaching. Based on the provided data, it is clear that our teaching has been well-received by the students, with most of our scores surpassing the Faculty averages in every aspect of the subject's general evaluation.

## Our feedback on specific comments on mandatory subjects:

We received several comments or recommendations in the evaluation documents from our students. The majority of textual comments were positive and praised many of our practical teachers and lecturers.

We have received several valuable comments from students, and we appreciate their feedback. We believe it's important to recognize that different professors and lecturers have their unique teaching styles, which can be valuable for a diverse student body.

Comments related to the teaching style and quality of specific teachers will be handled through direct, in-person discussions with the concerned teachers to ensure continuous improvement.

Two comments specifically criticized the teaching of a particular practice teacher. We have thoroughly discussed these concerns with the teacher and will continue to monitor his/her teaching closely. Moreover, we took into account the students' feedback in the group assignment of the indicated teacher.

We apologize for the changes made to the lecture schedule. These changes were primarily due to conferences organized by Semmelweis University. We made every effort to notify students via the NEPTUN system as soon as the new venues or technical details for the rescheduled lectures were confirmed.

Several comments mentioned concerns about the legibility of lecturers' handwriting during lectures. While we acknowledge these critiques, we would like to emphasize that the content written on the board is always announced orally. Additionally, lecturers make notes during class to allow students sufficient time to write down key points.

One student commented on the length of the lectures, expressing difficulty maintaining focus. While we understand the challenge, shortening the lectures is not feasible due to the constraints of the lecture hall schedules and the overall student timetable.

## Reflection on the implementation of the previous period's action plan ("implementation review"):

We have implemented measures to address numerous suggestions from students over the past year. For instance, significant concerns raised in previous semesters have been resolved, such as improving clarity on the grading system and removing outdated regulations from our webpage to avoid confusion. There have been no reports of misunderstandings related to these changes.

Additionally, we have instructed our teachers to emphasize the purpose of our weekly system, and no further critiques have been raised regarding this aspect.
