Action plan based on the student feedback received in the second semester of the 2022/23 academic year (FOKOELT349_2A)

Our feedback on general comments by the students:

We have received the results of the online questionnaires submitted by students regarding our teaching. Based on the provided data, it is clear that our teaching has been well-received by the students, with our scores surpassing the Faculty averages in every aspect of the subject's general evaluation.

Our feedback on specific comments on mandatory subjects:

We did not receive any specific comments or recommendations in the general evaluation document from our students.

We have received textual comments only in the evaluation form regarding the practicals. While the majority of textual comments were positive and praised some of our practical teachers, there was one specific concern raised by our students. They criticized the practice of holding weekly tests before the material had been thoroughly discussed in class. The teachers in our Department believe that this approach is the most effective way to motivate students to prepare themselves for a meaningful theoretical-practical experience. Due to time constraints during the theoretical portion of the practical sessions, teachers can only address the most essential and challenging questions from previous lectures. Consequently, the topics covered in the theoretical portion of the practical often do not align with the questions on the weekly tests.







Reflection on the implementation of the previous period's action plan ("implementation review"):

We have taken steps to address many of the suggestions provided by our students in the previous year. It's worth noting that the weekly test system had been previously criticized in last year's feedback as well. In response, we have communicated with our teachers, urging them to emphasize the significance and purpose of the weekly tests within the context of the Medical and Dental Physiology course for the students.
