

General Meeting of Delegates for the Students' Union of Semmelweis University

Election of officials in 2015

- (1) At Semmelweis University, to positions as members of the General Meeting of Delegates for SE HÖK any such student with active student status may be elected who submits a valid application until the deadline of registration.
- (2) The mandates of the General Meeting of Delegates for SE HÖK will be valid until the new By-Laws of SE HÖK is approved by the Senate, and at the latest until 31 May 2016. The mandate of any member of the General Meeting of Delegates for SE HÖK will begin on the business day following the effective announcement of the results of the election.
- (3) Participation in the election is conditioned on the submission of an application meeting the requirements of the call for applications. Decisions on the acceptance or disapproval of the received applications shall be made by the Election Committee.
- (4) Any application needs to include:
 - a) registration form,
 - b) certificate of active student status for the first term of the academic year of 2015/2016,
 - c) curriculum vitae,
 - d) letter of motivation,
 - e) written letter of commendation from at least 2% of the students having the right to vote at the candidate's Faculty. (*AOK: 91 persons, EKK: 12, ETK: 73, FOK: 18, GYTK: 17*)
 - f) The applicant is required to attach his or her signature to each page of the application.

Applications may as well be submitted by way of authorized agents, yet in this case the application should be appended with a letter of authorization in the form of a fully conclusive private deed.

- (6) Deadline for the submission of applications: **12:00 pm on 2 December 2015**
- (7) Applications have to be submitted in person: H-1085 Budapest, Üllői út 26. Floor II, room no. 214
- (8) Starting time of voting: **8:00 am, 8 December 2015**
End of voting: **20:00 pm, 12 December 2015**

The election procedure will be deemed as valid in case at least 25% of the full-time students with the right to vote have participated in it. Each student may cast votes in a number corresponding to the number of mandates that are granted at the Faculty concerned.

- (9) Mandates to the General Meeting of Delegates for SE HÖK will be granted to the students having received the largest number of votes in a number that corresponds to the number of mandates that can be granted at the given Faculty.
- (10) The number of votes will be summed up by the Election Committee comprising members to be delegated by the Rector, Chancellor and the HÖK President.
- (11) The election procedure is governed by the provisions of the Provisional Election Regulations.
