THE OLDEST MEDICAL SCHOOL IN HUNGARY

1769

The Faculty of Medicine was added to the University of Nagyszombat by Hungarian Queen Maria Theresa

1784

The university moved to Pest

1951

The Faculty of Medicine was reorganized into an independent medical school, and its name was changed to Budapest University of Medicine

1969

The university was named Semmelweis University of Medicine, in honour of Ignác Semmelweis on the Faculty's bicentennial

The Faculty of Medicine opened with five departments

1855

Ignác Semmelweis became appointed Professor of Theoretical and Practical Obstetrics at the University of Pest

1955

The Faculty of Dentistry and the Faculty of Pharmacy were established

The Faculty of Health Sciences was founded

2021

1983

German language training was launched

2000

Semmelweis University of Medicine merged with the Imre Haynal University of Health Sciences and the University of Physical Education, and it was renamed Semmelweis University

2017

The Pető Institute merged with the university and became an independent Faculty: the András Pető Faculty

2023

The 40th anniversary of launching international medical trainings



1989

English language training was launched

The Faculty of Health and Public Services was established

2019

The 250th anniversary of the establishment of Semmelweis University
