FAQ:

Certificates:

Q: How do I prove that I have done TDK work and what needs to be on it?

A: Please get a certificate from the Institute where you have done it (minimum 2 semesters in same institute or department) with exact period. In case you have started it in spring semester, we can give points for that semester as well.

Q: What kind of certificate do I need to prove Demonstrator work (Teaching assistant) with?

A: You need to upload work assignment contract to mobility-online or certificate you got from Department where you have worked at.

Q: If I am doing Demonstrator work for 2 semesters, do I have to enter 1 or 2 semesters?

A: Once you have started the second semester, it counts as two semesters.

Q: Does it count if I have participated at a scientific conference?

A: Yes, you can get points for it provided you upload the programme booklet or poster (please mark yourself on it) to SOP.

Q: I have participated at an academic competition. Is it enough to scan the certificate of it?

A: Please upload the certificate to Mobility-Online.

Q: Can I get points for attending academic competition?

A: No, please note that only students placed 1-3 can get points for it.

Q: I was wondering what type of format of health care employment certificate do you accept? Do you have a form for it? Is it enough if I get certificate from labour organisation at Semmelweis?

A: We do not have a form for it. The certificate should state the exact activity, place, duration (until hours!) and should be signed and stamped.

Language:

Q: Does my native language count as a language?

A: Not in this case, you cannot get points for it.

Q: In case my native language is not English or German, but I am studying at Semmelweis University in English or German program, can I get points for it? **A:** Yes, it counts as C1.

Q: I have a mark in my maturity (high school graduation) certificate in language. Does it count?

A: Yes, it counts, if it lists the level (B2).

Q: Can I get points for doing multiple language courses?

A: No, you cannot get points for language course.

Grade average:

We do not need copy of your Index, neither your Transcript of Records, we only need the form for weighted grade average. <u>Our example form</u>

Misc.:

Q: What does SMS and SMP mean? What is the difference?

A: SMS – Student Mobility Study (Study Mobility) SMP-Student Mobility Placement (Traineeship)

Q: Does it count if I am an ISSA member and how do I prove it?

A: Yes, it counts, if you are an active member of ISSA, please get membership certificate from them.

Q: Do I get points for compulsory traineeship?

A: No, you cannot receive points for mandatory traineeships, even for those carried out abroad. In case you stay longer, that counts.

Q: What does "Special training at Semmelweis University" tab mean on Mobility-Online system?

A: Semmelweis University has a special training in collaboration with Pázmány Péter Catholic University in field of bionics.

Traineeship places

Q: I have marked Germany as planned country of host institution on application form, however it is not confirmed that they will be able to host me. Does this cause any trouble?

A: No, that is why we name it PLANNED country of host institution. You can change your mind about it.

Q: Is there a full list of hospitals that are accepted by Semmelweis University?

A: No, unfortunately we do not have such a list, but the English Secretariat has one, titled: "Approved health institutes for 6th year rotations" under Rotation tab. <a href="http://semmelweis.hu/english/education/english-language-program/eng

Please note that you need to spend minimum of **2 months at one hospital** or clinic (department) that belongs to the same University. Please upload the Letter of Acceptance (e-mail is sufficient) you acquire from hospital (containing place and period) to mobility-online.
