Dear Guests and Colleagues,

It is our privilege to invite you to the **3rd Central European Nursing Conference**, to be held at the Faculty of Health Sciences, Semmelweis University, on **14-15 November 2025**. Fifty years ago, Hungary established its first Faculty of Health Sciences within the framework of the Postgraduate Medical Institute, taking decisive steps toward the development of higher education in nursing. Thirty-five years ago, the first full-time diploma nursing program commenced in Budapest. The 1990s created the conditions for the launch of college-level nursing programs in several cities across the country, each supported by distinguished universities. Subsequent university integrations and alignment with European Union standards laid the foundation for further development and for enhancing the quality of education.

Since then, nursing education has undergone remarkable transformation. Today, programs are conducted under state-of-the-art educational conditions, supported by the most advanced teaching technologies. Numerous national, European, and international projects have contributed - and continue to contribute - to the advancement of nursing education. Even prior to Hungary's accession to the European Union, the first graduates of master's-level nursing programs entered the profession, lending new momentum to the development of nursing. Parallel to this, opportunities opened for nurses in the field of health sciences to engage in research and pursue academic degrees.

A further milestone was reached in the 2017/2018 academic year with the launch of specialized nursing education at the university level, following several years of preparation. Since 2021, Hungary has formally recognized advanced practice nursing education, with six areas of specialization offering graduates enhanced competencies, expanded professional authority, and new responsibilities. The importance of nurses holding bachelor's and master's degrees is now well established in the domestic labour market, while advanced practice nurses are increasingly recognized as key contributors to healthcare delivery.

With this background, the Faculty of Health Sciences, Semmelweis University, in collaboration with Faculty of Health Sciences, Medical University of Lublin and the Chair of Integrated Nursing Care, Faculty of Health Sciences, Medical University of Lublin, Jessenius Faculty of Medicine in Martin, Department of Nursing, Comenius University in Bratislava, Faculty of Medicine, Department of Nursing and Midwifery, University of Ostrava, is honoured to host the 3rd Central European Nursing Conference.

The conference aims to provide an academic platform for sharing professional experiences, presenting current research, and addressing both common and country-specific challenges in nursing practice and education.

We warmly welcome colleagues from all areas of nursing past and present, academic and clinical to join us for this important international meeting in Budapest.



About Budapest

Brief Introduction:

Budapest, one of the most beautiful capitals in Europe, spans both sides of the Danube River. It is known for its stunning architecture, historic thermal baths, and vibrant cultural life. The city offers a perfect blend of history, art, and modern life for its visitors.

Weather:

In November, the average temperature ranges between 8–12 °C, with colder days possible. It's recommended to wear warm, layered clothing, along with a coat and scarf. Rain is more frequent, and evenings can be quite chilly, so carrying an umbrella and dressing in layers is advisable.

Currency & Payment Options:

The official currency is the **Hungarian Forint (HUF)**, but credit cards are widely accepted, especially in larger restaurants and stores. ATMs are readily available, and card payments are a convenient way to make purchases.



From the Airport to the City Center:

- Public Transportation: We strongly recommend using public transportation as it is both quick and affordable. The BKK 100E bus connects Budapest Airport directly to the city center, with a stop at Kálvin tér, which is close to the Semmelweis University Faculty of Health Sciences. The journey takes approximately 30-40 minutes. For more detailed information on ticket prices and schedules, please visit: BKK Ticket Information.
- **Taxi:** A taxi from the airport to the city center takes approximately 25–30 minutes, costing around 6000–8000 HUF, depending on traffic. It is recommended to use the official taxi services available at the taxi stand to avoid overcharging.
- **Transfer Services:** Several private transfer services are available from the airport to the city center. These can be booked online in advance, with prices ranging from 6000-10000 HUF.

Public Transportation

Passenger transport on a single day is provided by some **1,900 buses**, **trams**, **trolleybuses**, **metro and suburban railway trains**, which have more than 43 thousand departures combined.

Beside these options you can also travel with our public bike-sharing service **MOL Bubi**, **taxi** or **special transport services** like the **Funicular**, **Chairlift**, or **boat**.

BKK App / BudapestGO:

The BKK and BudapestGO mobile apps help with purchasing tickets, viewing timetables, and selecting the best routes. **These apps are available for both** Android and iOS devices and are free of charge, significantly enhancing the convenience of traveling around the city.



Public Transportation to Semmelweis University Faculty of Health Sciences:

The Semmelweis University Faculty of Health Sciences is easily accessible by public transportation, located in the 8th district of Budapest. The nearest metro stations, tram lines, and bus routes provide convenient access to the university.

Metro:

M4 (Green Line): The closest metro station to the university is **Kálvin tér (M4)**, which is a short walk from the Faculty of Health Sciences. From here, you can quickly reach the university by foot.

Tram:

Tram Line 4 & 6: These tram lines run along Rákóczi út and **stop** at Kálvin tér. From there, it's a short walk to the university.

Bus:

Several buses stop near the university, including *Bus 9, 72, and 83* at the **Kálvin tér stop**. From here, you can easily walk to the university campus.
