

**Notification**  
**for all students of the Faculty of Health Sciences of Semmelweis University**

The Faculty's Medical Office – having consulted with the University's Occupational Health Service - notifies students about the following:

1. Health and hygiene fitness test is required for studies, including field internships.

All students must have the aptitude test completed **once a year**.

In order to obtain it, you must appear at the Faculty's Medical Clinic once a year and bring your chest x-ray report not older than 1 year and a complete blood count and a urine test not older than 3-6 months.

2. All students must have Hepatitis B protection. The students of the following majors are exempted from this rule:

- BSc Dietetics
- BSc Public Health Inspector
- BSc Optometrist
- BSc Health Tourism organizer

*Note:* Hepatitis B immunity is usually proved by students during the enrolment procedure, when they had to present a positive Anti-HBs test. In these cases, no further proof is required during the academic years.

3. If the student participates in an area practice that is of special interest from an epidemiological perspective (maternity room, premature newborn and child ward practices), in order to start the practice, they must have negative stool bacteriological screening test and VDRL (Lues serology) with a negative finding within six months and declare that they have not suffered from a relevant illness in the meantime. Even though it is no longer necessary to present these documents in the Clinic, in practice they can be asked for it.
