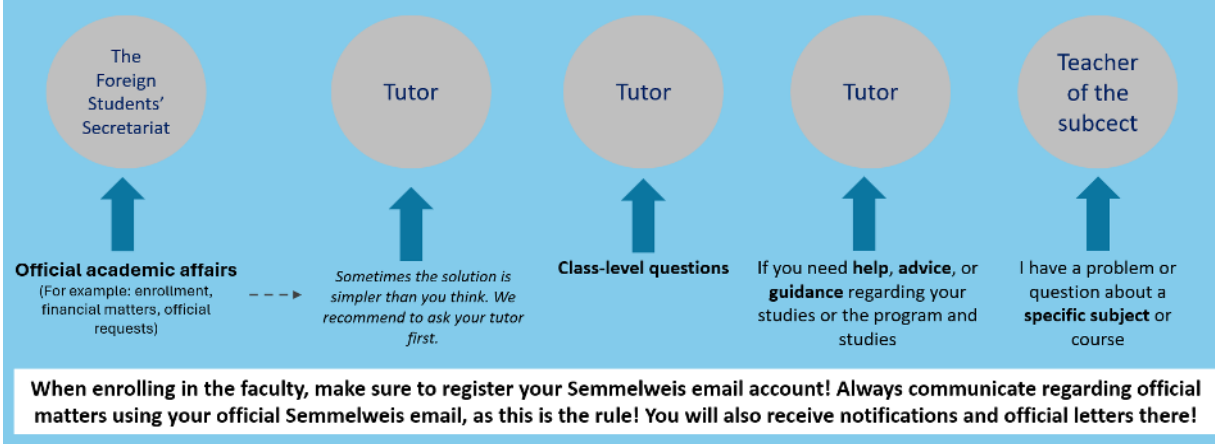

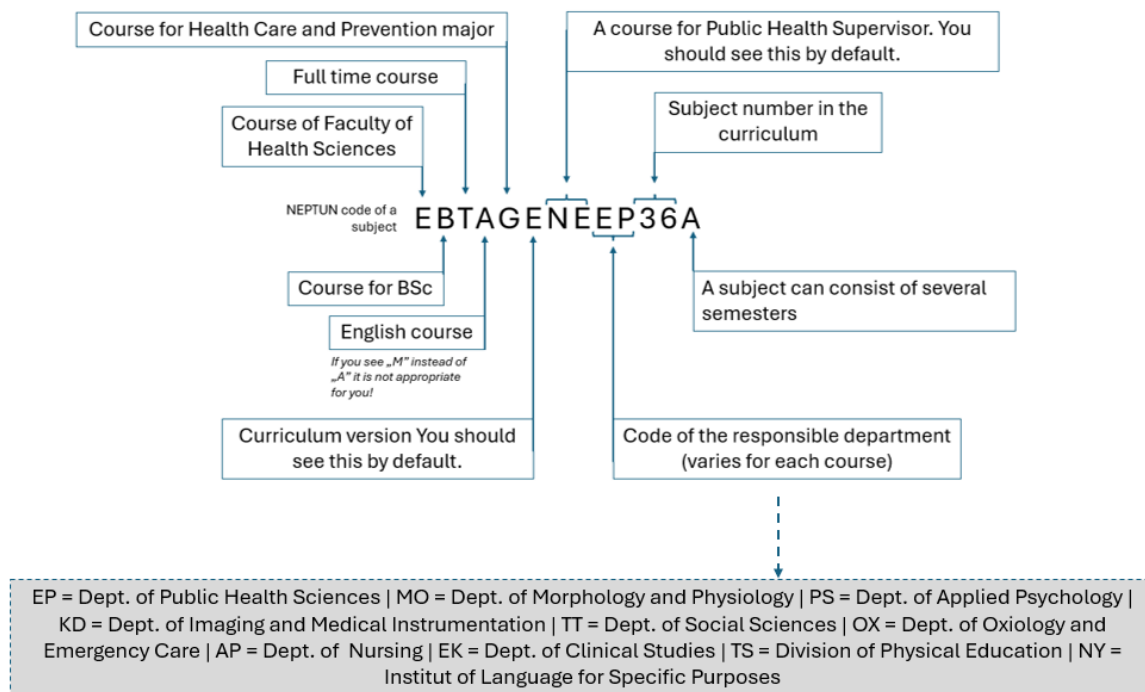

The department manages the Public Health Supervisor BSc program. The department will teach you several courses and organize professional internships. **DO NOT FORGET TO REPORT ANY PROBLEMS TO YOUR TUTOR FIRST!** It is not necessary to write to the department or another organizational unit immediately.

If I have a problem with a course, how do I know which department to contact?

You have several options

1. Note the name and contact information of the instructor in the first class
2. The subject curricula (found on the MOODLE interface) include both the department and the instructor
3. Each subject has a code in the study system (NEPTUN code). The meaning of this code is as follows:



Most importantly, if you have a problem with a course, contact your teacher first. If it doesn't work, let your tutor know!
