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Student evaluation of teaching work Action plan for the first semester evaluation 2021/2022 Semmelweis University, Faculty of Pharmacy, Department of Pharmacognosy

In the first semester of the academic year 2021/2022, the compulsory courses taught by the Institute of Pharmacognosy include History of Pharmacy and Propaedeutics (theory) (GYKFMG153E1A), Pharmacognosy (theory) II. (GYFMGGNDE2A) and Pharmacognosy (practice) II. (GYFMGGNDG2A) all received positive ratings compared to the faculty average (overall scores: 5.69, 0.41 and 2.38).

On the other hand, Pharmaceutical Botany (Theory) II. (GYKFMG079E2A) and Pharmaceutical Botany (Practice) II. (GYKFMG079G2A), taught to third-year pharmacy students, scored negatively compared to the faculty average (-4.43 and -4.70, respectively). However, as the percentage of questionnaire completers for the latter two subjects was less than 30%, none of the scores for the questions were significantly different from the faculty averages, and no detailed written assessment was provided, no action can be taken to improve the results.
