Action plan of the Department of Prosthodontics in connection with the educational activities of the department based on student feedback

I. Action plans for education

- The preparation of a textbook as soon as possible with the exception of the subject of gnatology - is the most important and urgent request of the students for all subjects. During the desktop publishing of the textbook, the department will publish the already completed chapters in a protected form on the clinic's website.
- 2. The retention of special teaching methods developed in line with the epidemiological situation is one of the future plans of the department. Thus, the department increases the number of seminar classes that allow for greater interactivity and communication. This is possible during both lectures and practices.
- 3. The subjects taught by the department contain a very high number of practical training. Summarizing the needs expressed by the students, the department pays special attention in this regard to provide the students as much teaching assistance as possible in the practices.
- 4. The material presented in the practices will be made available on the clinic's website similarly to the presentations of the lectures.
- 5. The department will make great efforts to ensure that the teaching material provided in both the lectures and the practices covers the curriculum required for the exams.
- 6. In more than half of the subjects taught by the department, students are involved in patient care. Providing patients for the students is in many cases hampered by reasons beyond the department. An additional problem with this is that students are assigned to a different practice supervisor every semester. Therefore, the department will develop a continuously updated library of documents for the patient care system so that, as far as possible, all students have uniform access to patients during their six semesters at the department.

II. Action plan for infrastructure

1. Acquisition of additional digital cameras required for student documentation.

III. Action plans for educational discipline

- 1. The department strictly strives to start and finish the practices on time.
- 2. The department minimizes the replacement of practice supervisors.
- 3. The department pays special attention to the development of the professional german language skills of the instructors.

IV. Action plans to increase student interest

- The department would like to increase the student attendance of the lectures
 by partially switching to the seminar-type teaching methodology already
 mentioned above, in the case of subjects where the curriculum provides an
 opportunity for such a form of training.
- 2. In order to increase the attendance of the lectures, the department strives to deliver the material required for the exams.
- 3. The Questionnaire about subject registration, exploring motivation opportunities for Course Evaluation was filled in by a small number of students studying in the foreign language programs. In order to strengthen student participation, the department draws the attention of students to the importance of participating in the survey in order to raise the standard of education.
