The goals and place of the course in regards to the education of dental students:

To improve the theoretical knowledge and practical experience of the previous clinical semesters, and to prepare student's patients for regular subject programs.

Competences acquired by completion of the course:

By completing the practice, students get higher skill-level in independent patient care.

Pre-study requirements and prerequisites of course registration and completion, in case of a multi-semester subject, the standpoint of the educational-research unit on the concurrent subject registration and on the requirements of permission thereof :

Prosthodontics III., Restorative Dentistry and Endodontics III., Periodontology II.

Concurrent subject registration is not possible.

Number of students required for announcement of course (*min., max.*), method of selection:

12 students, which is distributed among Hungarian, English and German speaking students according to the number of students in the year. The selection is made in order of application.

<p>Detailed course/lecture description¹: <i>(to facilitate credit recognition in other institutions)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - clinical practice in pairs - four-handed treatment, on one side as an assistant and the other half of the practice on medical side - examination of patients - complete diagnostics and making treatment plans - patient pathway protocol (referral to a specialist) - pre-prosthetic treatments <ul style="list-style-type: none"> conservative dentistry endodontics simpler treatment of gnathology, oral surgery, periodontology
<p>Courses (<i>compulsory and obligatory elective</i>) which in part or entirely overlap the topics of above course: General Dental Materials Odontotechnology and Prosthodontics Preclinical Course I – III. Prosthodontics I – V. Clinical Dentistry I – II. Gnathology</p>
<p>Special academic work required for completion of the course²: -</p>
<p>Attendance on practices and lectures, replacement in case of missed sessions: Students must attend at the practices No more than a 25% of the practices are allowed to be missed for any reason – not even with a medical certificate – otherwise the semester will not be accepted. Medical certificate can only be accepted after verification. A student is considered to be late from the practice if he/she arrives no more than 15 minutes later than the time set by the schedule. These late arrivals are marked on the attendance sheet and if someone is late three times will be considered as an absence. But in case student can be allowed to attend the practice, registered on the sheet too. No extra possibilities will be provided for missed sessions.</p> <p>The use of cell phones during the practices is forbidden. (Unless the patient is photographed.) If the student uses his / her mobile phone despite the warning of his / her instructor, he / she will be not allowed to continue the practice and will have to leave the room immediately. During the practices, students can use tablets, notebooks, and small laptops to take notes. Handling the photo documentation, patient rights and data protection rules must be strictly adhered to. Photo documentation can only be used for the case reports on the final exam.</p>
<p>Method of checking acquired knowledge during the study period³: No midterms or exams.</p>
<p>Requirements of an accepted semester (<i>signature of the lecturer</i>): Students fulfill the course requirements by completing attendance (presence) and patient care.</p>

<p>Grading of courses⁴. The possibility and requirements of an offered grade: Practical mark At the end of the practice, students get practical mark. Students get the practical mark from the valuation of their theoretical and practical work, such as behavior and attitude during the practices. Practical mark is considered unsatisfactory if the average of the partial practical grades are not over a 2,0 average. No offered grade.</p>
