Oral pathology for the students of the Faculty of Dentistry

The Department of Pathology and Experimental Cancer Research at Semmelweis University invites applications for teaching assistant (TA) fellowships. Candidates can apply for a 1 (one) semester fellowship terminating at the end of the second semester of the academic year 2024/2025 (May 2025).

Selection criteria

Only those may apply who are:

- active students enrolled in academic years 4-5 at the Semmelweis University;
- apply for demonstratorship in only one (1) subject/department;
- prove commitment and a responsible attitude towards participation in the teaching process;
- have previously proven excellence in the subjects of pathology and oral pathology and have successful *final examinations (at least grade 4)* from the subject listed above (both);

Please note that only two positions are available and the demonstratorships expire in the end of the academic year (2024/2024 2nd semester).

Role of departmental TAs

Demonstrators are student instructors who work in association with faculty members during histology classes and or autopsy classes or seminars. They are supervised by a faculty member who continuously follows their progress to both provide help with

advancing their knowledge as well as exerting control over their teaching activities.

Duties of departmental demonstrators

- Demonstrators are expected to be present during the weekly practices (histology classes/autopsy classes). Absences may not exceed 25% or the semester is not accepted.
- Demonstrators should possess adequate communication skills and adequate proficiency skills in English language.
- They have to be well prepared to help both with the practical and theoretical questions.

Duty of confidence

Demonstrators should meet critical GDPR requirements, therefore all personal data, facts and pieces of information they learn about during their activities should be processed without breaching confidentiality. Confidential information should not be shared with or made available for a third person.

Requirements for the credit

1. No more than the allowed absences.
2. Active participation during the seminars/classes (as decided by the instructor).
