The goals of the course in point of view of the education: Competences acquired by completion of the course: After completing the subjects of Oral Surgery Propedeutics and Oral Surgery I, the students will get acquainted with the conditions of providing a hygienic work environment, the basic oral surgical instruments, the tools and techniques required for anesthesia. They learn to perform tooth extraction with pliers on a professional basis. During the summer practice, they can not only learn the individual steps separately, but also participate in the entire process. They can follow patients from the first examination to the therapeutic solution while participating the whole process. They can study the recognition and treatment of certain complications. Under constant control, they can perform basic tooth extractions and assist with outpatient oral surgery. They can also get an overview of the complex workflow of the outpatient oral surgery department.
