The goals of the course in point of view of the education: The purpose of the subject, that the dental student would be able to recognize and cope with the possible daily emergency cases at the dental practice. In the 21st century dental emergency does not mean only extractions. It also includes Conservative Dentistry, Prosthetic, Pedodontics, Orthodontics as well as Periodontic aspects. The curriculum of the Community dentistry is an integral part of the other subjects. This special field of dentistry is necessary to teach separately, that the introduction of individual cases in community dentistry help with understanding of other field of dentistry as well. Especially important this subject for graduates, as they do not possess yet enough theoretical and practical knowledge, which would make them capable to solve any emergency case with ease. Department of Community Dentistry is responsible for all Budapest and Pest county dental care, therefore is able to provide sufficient number of patients for practical education.

It is a synthesizing subject that deal with all part of dentistry.

Special academic work required for completion of the course³:

During the practices, the student documents a case (which was diagnosed and provided by her/himself) and prepares a case study in the form of a presentation. It will be send to the lecturer by the end of the semester.
