




# 3. Gyógyszerészi gondozás (elmélet+gyakorlat) Neptun kódja: GYKEGY096E1A





### 5. Klinikai gyógyszerészet (elmélet+gyakorlat) Neptun kódja: GYKEGY100E1A





#### Our general comments to the students' evaluation:

Despite this limitation, we are refining our ongoing initiatives, such as problem-based learning and teambased project work, as integral components of our practice-oriented case studies. These approaches are designed to foster a deeper understanding of the subject matter.

We highlight that all presentation materials are accessible on the Moodle platform, which serves as a valuable resource for exam preparation. The positive outcomes in each subject's exams suggest that these materials effectively supported students' preparation. Therefore, we will continue to utilize this strategy in future academic cycles. Furthermore, we intend to provide personal consultation opportunities.

We remain committed to providing updated and comprehensive learning resources to enhance exam preparation and equip our international students with the skills necessary for success in a multicultural professional environment.
